



Peripatetic Teaching – Job Description.

Bromley Youth Music Trust (BYMT) was established to provide a high quality comprehensive instrumental and vocal music education to the young people of Bromley and the surrounding area, through individual and group tuition in schools, as well as providing opportunities for performance in a wide range of settings to enhance the musical understanding and appreciation of the pupils and the wider community. The Bromley Music Education Hub's focus is therefore to:

Work with schools to deliver a high-quality music service to students which will allow them to develop their musical potential.

The Hub's key objectives are to:

- Provide opportunities for young people, whatever their circumstances, to learn to play a musical instrument, to extend their musical knowledge and obtain appropriate qualifications.
- Provide a centre of excellence for group activities, such as choirs and ensembles, to develop the skills of young musicians.
- Provide opportunities for young musicians to play in front of audiences, to gain experience of public performance.
- Promote the participation of individuals and groups in music competitions and festivals, both locally and nationally and on international tours, to enhance the reputation of Bromley's music and musicians.
- All this to be delivered at the highest possible levels of quality.

The BMEH welcomes both children and adults from outside the Borough to join its activities.

Responsibilities

The appointee will:

- Teach in schools, both primary and secondary as required by the Head of Department.
- Teach both group and individual one-to-one lessons.
- Promote BYMT Ensembles and Activities and encourage pupils to attend.
- Maintain accurate registers of attendance for all pupils and return these to BYMT at the end of each term.
- Operate the BYMT instrumental hire scheme as appropriate.
- Attend safeguarding and CPD sessions whenever possible.
